NOTIFICATION OF FINAL SUBMISSION

Application for the postponement of compliance timeframes in terms of Regulation 11 of Section 21 of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act - Minimum Emission Standards, for Sasol South Africa (Pty) Ltd Operations in Sasolburg

Dear Interested and Affected Party

We would like to thank all Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) who participated in the 2017 postponement application process for the Sasol South Africa (Pty) Ltd Operations in Sasolburg (SO).

Between 2013 and 2014 Sasol undertook a process to apply for postponements from the 2015 compliance timeframes of the Minimum Emission Standards (MES). Sasol was granted postponements for a number of its operations by the National Air Quality Officer (NAQO) with the concurrence of the licensing officer. In some instances, and for some sources, postponements were granted for less than five years as initially requested. In these instances, Sasol will be challenged to meet the compliance requirements within the specified timeframes. SO therefore has applied for further postponements for the incinerators located in the Sasol One complex in Sasolburg where postponements were previously only granted for three years. This application is supported by Part 2 of the MES.

Submission of Final Postponement Application

All I&APs are hereby notified that in accordance with the legal requirements for postponements as specifically contained in the MES, Sasol has submitted the application including the finalised documents listed below to the National Air Quality Officer (NAQO) in support of its postponement application:

1. A Motivation Report, detailing the justification and reasons for the application.
2. An Atmospheric Impact Report (AIR).
3. Independent Peer Review Report of the AIR.
4. A Public Participation Report.
5. Comments and Response Report.
6. Redacted Atmospheric Emission Licence.
7. Annual Emissions Report.
