Approval of the Environmental Authorisation in terms of the National Environment Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA) as amended, and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014 in respect of the proposed Fine Chrome Recovery (FCR) Plant on the farm Amandelbult 383 KQ Portion 0, situated in the Thabazimbi Local Municipality: Limpopo Province

Notification of the Environmental Authorisation (EA)

The Limpopo Provincial Government Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE) granted authorisation on 11 March 2020 (first notification to SRK received on 17 March 2020) to Rustenburg Platinum Mines Limited (RPM), Amandelbult Complex (Amandelbult) for the proposed FCR Plant project, in terms of NEMA.
