REMINDER: INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE AND COMMENT

Application for the postponement of compliance timeframes in terms of Regulation 11 of the Section 21 of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act - Minimum Emission Standards, for Sasol South Africa (Pty) Ltd Synfuels Operations in Secunda

Dear Stakeholder

Sasol South Africa (Pty) Limited through its Secunda Synfuels Operations (SSO) owns and operates a petrochemical facility in Secunda, Mpumalanga, among others. SSO is located in the Sasol Secunda complex south of central Secunda. Sasol is required to comply with Minimum Emission Standards (MES), published in terms of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act (Act No 39 of 2004).

Between 2013 and 2014 Sasol undertook a process to apply for postponements from the 2015 compliance timeframes of the Minimum Emissions Standards (MES) Government Notice No. 893 in Government Gazette 37054 of 22 November 2013 ("GN 893"), in terms of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act (Act No. 39 of 2004) (NEM:AQA). Sasol was granted postponements for a number of its operations by the National Air Quality Officer (NAQO) with the concurrence of the licensing officer. In some instances and for some sources, postponements were granted for less than five years as initially requested. In these instances, Sasol may not be able to meet the compliance requirements within the specified timeframes. SSO therefore intends to apply for further postponements for their Incinerators and Phenosolvan Plant where postponements were only granted for three years.

This application is supported by Part 2 of the MES. In accordance with the requirements for postponements contained in the MES, Sasol will submit an Atmospheric Impact Report (AIR) together with detailed justification and reasons. Airshed Planning Professionals (Pty) Ltd (Airshed) were appointed to prepare the AIR while SRK Consulting (South Africa) (Pty) Ltd (SRK) has been appointed to undertake the public participation process to also assist Sasol in compiling the Motivation Report containing the justification and reasons.
