**APPROVAL OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME:
ADDENDUM TO THE MODIKWA MINE EMP FOR PROSPECTING
PURPOSES: MODIKWA PLATINUM MINE**

The abovementioned approval of the Environmental Management Programme, which has been signed by the Director: Mineral Development, Limpopo Region, is hereby approved in terms of Section 39 of the Minerals Act, 1991 (Act 50 of 1991), as amended and is applicable to the mining area as depicted, subject to the following conditions.

1. The Environmental Management Programme shall conform to the Environmental Management Programme as approved.
2. Mining activities shall conform to all relevant legislations, especially the National Water Act, 1998, and such other conditions as may be imposed by the Director: Mineral Development or any other officer of this office, duly authorized thereto.
3. Rehabilitation of the disturbed surface caused by mining activities shall comply with the provisions of this programme.
4. Financial provision in the form of a Rehabilitation Trust and/or Financial Guarantee or any other approved method must be submitted to this office.

5. At least 60 (sixty) days before the end of each of its financial years thereafter, the company shall, in consultation with the relevant statutory authorities, cause written estimates to be prepared of the probable cost of rehabilitation measures that will be required in order to comply with the aforementioned statutory obligations. Such written estimates shall be prepared by a suitably qualified person and full particulars of which shall be submitted to this office.
6. The financial provision shall be adjusted annually to conform with the abovementioned estimation.
7. A performance assessment, monitoring and evaluation report must be submitted annually to this office or as determined by the Director: Mineral Development.
8. Any alteration or deviation from the programme shall be submitted to the Director: Mineral Development for his approval.
9. During mining period the requirements of the Mine Health and Safety Act, 1996 (Act 29 of 1996) must be complied with.

Your attention is also directed to the requirement of section 54 of the Minerals Act, 1991. A copy of the Environmental Management Programme must always be available on the mine for inspection by duly authorized officers.
